SHE HAS BEEN HIS PERSONAL ASSISTANT SINCE 1997, WHEN SHE GRADUATED CENTRAL SAINT MARTINS. IN 2000, SHE WAS APPOINTED HEAD OF WOMEN'S WEAR FOR HIS HOUSE. SHE HAD WORKED CLOSELY WITH HIM FOR 13 YEARS.

FOLLOWING MCQUEEN'S DEATH IN FEBRUARY 2010, GUCCI HAD CONFIRMED THAT THE BRAND WOULD CONTINUE, AND APPOINTED HER NEW CREATIVE DIRECTOR.
